CLASS TIME:

There will be three days of instruction and an exam on the last day. The course **will begin at 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, March 21st**. Class will be from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. There will be an exam on Friday starting at 8:30 a.m. and you have three hours to complete the exam. The exam will consist of 50 questions and there is a 70% requirement for passing. Pass or fail notification will be provided to each individual and the Oklahoma Tax Commission.

HOTEL INFORMATION:
